Public Works Report

Gravel Roads

Graders are continuing their efforts on preparing all roads for the winter season. The Patch Gravelling program has been completed.

Surfaced Roads

Additional line painting in the County was completed on October 26th & October 29th on the following roads:

- Airport Road,
- Alhambra Road,
- Condor Road,
- Northfork Road,
- Old Hwy 11A,
- Red Deer River Access Road

Crews will continue with hand patching and asphalt repairs as weather permits and will help with yard and facilities maintenance as needed.

Winter sand haul and pickling operations at the North Facility was completed on October 30th.

Winter sand haul to the Caroline Yard was completed on November 5th. Pickling operations in the Caroline Yard are expected to complete by days end November 7th.

Winter on-call rotation began on November 1st and plow trucks have been dispatched several times.

Remaining snow fence will be installed, weather permitting, and when personnel is available.

Maintenance

Gravel crushing, within Smith Pit, located at NE 31-37-08-W5M, is anticipated to be completed the week of November 12th. Once completed in the Smith Pit, crushing will commence within the Martin Pit, located at NE 13-39-08-W5M.

Condor Lift Station Phase 2 Upgrades are concluding. Crews are focusing on electrical hookups and cleanup. Anticipate commissioning of the Lift Station to occur prior to month end.

Construction on BF 81567, located on Twp. Rd. 42-0 over the East Lobstick Creek (NE-34-41-6-W5), is concluding. The road is scheduled to be open the week of November 12th.

Construction on BF 09970, located on Range Road 6-1 (Bingley Road), over the Lobstick Creek (NW 36-40-06-W5M), is concluding. The road is scheduled to be open the week of November 12th, if not sooner.

Repair(s) and replacement of sidewalks, in Leslieville and Condor, commenced on October 18^{th} , 2018 and was partially completed for the season as of November 2^{nd} . Approximately $\frac{2}{3}$ of the project was complete and they will return in the spring of 2019 to finish the remainder.

Ditching projects, and most of the culvert work for 2018, have started to wrap up for the season due to weather.

Gravel Road Rehabilitation

The Shoulder Pull Crew on Rge. Rd. 5-4, south of Hwy. 11, has completed the 3200 m project. Crew and Equipment have been shut down for the season.

Re-Hab Crew has completed Rge. Rd. 8-4 (Cow Creek Road) and final cleanup has done. Crew and equipment have been shut down for the season.

Re-Hab Crew on Rge. Rd. 5-4, south of Twp. Rd. 38-4, has completed road grade with final cleanup underway on borrow site. Crew on Twp. Rd. 38-4 between Rge. Rd. 5-5 and Rge. Rd. 6-0 has completed road grade with borrow site cleanup underway.

Base/Pave Projects

Taimi Road – Pidherney's has completed project with final inspection done on November 7th. Deficiencies were noted and repaired that day.

Nordegg Manufactured Home Park

PME has completed surface earthworks and MPE conducted a site inspection Nov. 1st and noted deficiencies are to be repaired for contract completion. PME was hopeful of finishing repairs before end of 2018.

West Country Road Project

Northfork Road Phase 2

Netook Construction has the road grade for the entire 5.65 km project in place with two short sections at the west end not meeting compaction standard. Bottom lift gravel has been placed on grade throughout and top lift to approximately km 17. Ditches have been cut and topsoil put in place with final cleanup to be done in 2019. Winter shut down meeting is slated for Nov. 13th, 2018.

Facilities

New Public Works Facility

The contractor and staff are continuing to work on the shop and office renovations for the New Public Works Facility.

Condor Public Services Building

Staff has made a conditional offer to purchase property located within the SW5- 39- 4 W5M to facilitate the New Condor Public Services building. Next steps include the application for rezoning and subdivision.
