## Public Works Report

## Gravel Roads

Graders are continuing their efforts on soft areas.
Patch gravelling is currently under-way and crews are coming out of the Varty Stockpile site.

## Surfaced Roads

The Ratepayer dust suppression application program for MG-30 has been completed. A total of $70 \mathrm{MG}-30$ residential contracts have been completed.

The Ratepayer dust suppression application program for SB-90 is anticipated to be completed the week of July $27^{\text {th }}$. A total of 46 SB- 90 residential contracts will be completed. Warranty maintenance and repair work, of dust suppression programs still in effect, should be completed by the middle of July, weather permitting.

The application of MG-30 dust suppression to high maintenance hills and intersections is anticipated to begin the week of July $9^{\text {th }}$, weather permitting.

Line painting, of surfaced roads, is anticipated to begin the week of July $9^{\text {th }}, 2018$.
Crews are completing temporary cold mix repairs on surfaced roads throughout the County as well as hand patching SB-90 dust suppression areas. Asphalt repairs are, tentatively, scheduled to be completed by August $31^{\text {st }}, 2018$.

Crack Sealing, of Clearwater County surfaced roads, is approximately $40 \%$ completed.

## Maintenance

Construction on BF 78043, located on Township Road 40-3 (SW 22-40-07-W5M), is anticipated to start on July $12^{\text {th }}$, 2018. The project is scheduled to take approximately 10 working days.

Gravel crushing, within Irwin Pit, located at SE $01-35-05-W 5 M$, has begun and is ongoing. Once completed in the Irwin Pit, crushing will commence within the Cooper Pit, located at SW 11-37-06-W5M.

Culverts are being assessed for blockages and replacement for the 2018 program.
County signs continue to be replaced, repaired and washed as needed.
The Beaver Control program has begun and will continue until October $31^{\text {st }}, 2018$.

Washing has been completed on bridge structures, located on surfaced and gravel roads.

Guardrail repair work, on bridge structures and roadways, has begun.

## Gravel Road Rehabilitation

The Shoulder Pull crew has started on Twp. Rd. 39-0 (Speight Road) and has approximately 1600 m completed of the 4200 m project.

The Re-Hab Crew, on Twp. Rd. 37-2A going east of Wall Street, has finished the 3200 m project. Crew has moved to Twp. 37-4 going from Wall street (R.R. 4-3) to Range Road 4-1 and has roughed in 400 m of the 3200 m project.

The Re-Hab Crew, on Township Road 40-3A, has roughed in the 1600 m project with clean up underway. Crew has started on Range Road 5-5 with 100 m roughed in on the 800 m project.

Spring Road Assessments are almost complete with $95 \%$ of roads in the county having been assessed. Mostly west country roads remain to be assessed.

## Base/ Pave Projects

Taimi Road - Pidherney's has a preconstruction meeting scheduled for Wednesday, July $11^{\text {th }}$ with a tentative construction start date of July $23^{\text {rd }}$.

Rocky Wood Road - Pidherney's has roughed in the 1300m project. Final cleanup is underway with base gravel to start July $16^{\text {th }}$ and paving tentatively scheduled for July $20^{\text {th }}$, weather permitting.

Condor Road - Pidherney's are slated to start construction July $13^{\text {th }}$, weather permitting.

## West Country Road Project

## Northfork Road Phase 2

Netook Construction has completed 700 m of road from the south end of the project.

Netook has another 2000m of road grade being worked and has stripped 4000m of right of way on the Northfork Road.

## Northfork Road Phase 1

Netook has finished final cleanup and had a final inspection on June $27^{\text {th }}$ and had the deficiencies repaired on the $28^{\text {th }}$.
