Public Works Report

Gravel Roads

Graders have commenced spring maintenance of roadways and are continuing their efforts on soft areas.

Patch gravelling is currently underway.

Surfaced Roads

A tender closed on Friday May 4th, 2018, for the application of dust suppression within Clearwater County. A total of two (2) bids were received with **Kortech Calcium Services Ltd.** being the low valid bidder. The cost of dust suppression came in within the operations budget. Application of dust suppression is anticipated to begin in June.

Frost probes are continually being checked. Three frost probes, located on Prairie Creek Road, Crammond Road and Caroline South Road show that frost is now out of the ground. The frost probes located on Wall Street, Centerview Road and Buster Creek Road has approximately 30 cm of frost remaining.

Street sweeping of highways has been completed.

Crews are completing temporary cold mix repairs on surfaced roads throughout the County as well as hand patching dust control areas. Asphalt repairs tentatively are scheduled to be completed by August 1st, 2017.

Dust suppressions, under warranty, are currently being assessed for repairs within 2018.

Crews are getting ready for the dust suppression program which will commence on June 1st.

Maintenance

A tender closed on May 3rd, 2018, for the bridge structure rehabilitation construction of BF 13970 (NE 18-37-05-W5M). A total of ten (10) bid packages were received with **Volker Stevin Highways Ltd.** being the low valid bidder. The cost of BF 13970 came in \$67,070.00 under the engineer's estimated amount of \$590,963.00. Construction to be completed in 2018.

A tender closed on Tuesday April 24th, 2018 for the construction of Phase Two upgrades to the Condor Lift Station. A total of three (3) bid packages were received

with **Timcon Construction Ltd.** being the low valid bidder. Timcon has accepted the project and construction is to be completed within 2018. The Condor Lift Station, Phase 2 upgrades received funding via the Government of Canada's Clean Water and Wastewater Fund.

Culverts are being assessed for blockages and replacement for the 2018 program.

County signs continue to be replaced, repaired and washed as needed.

The Beaver Control program has begun and will continue until October 31st, 2018.

Bridge structures, located on surfaced and gravel roads, are being cleaned and washed.

Gravel Road Rehabilitation

Crews are starting today on 2018 Rehabilitation and Shoulder Pull projects, weather permitting.

Shoulder Pull crew is starting on Twp. Rd. 41-0 going east of S.H. 761 for 6.4 km.

One Re-Hab crew is on Twp. Rd. 37-2A going east of Wall Street for 3.2 km.

Second Re-Hab crew is on Twp. Rd. 40-1A going east of Taimi Road for 1.6 km.

Base/ Pave Projects

Taimi Road – Pidherney's has a tentative start date of late July – early August 2018.

Both Condor and Rocky Wood Road projects are slated to begin the 28th of May, weather permitting.

West Country Road Project

Netook Construction began stripping right of way on Friday, May 11th on Northfork Road Phase 2.

Netook has started on the south first kilometre of Northfork Road Phase 2 with road construction.
