The Public Hearing process was outlined by Reeve Vandermeer.

K. Gilham reviewed the application from Brian and Beverley MacCharles to redesignate +/- 99.0 acres within the subject quarter section located at SW 15 36 06 W5M, from Recreation Facility District "RF" to Agriculture District "A"

In 2009, the applicants received approval to rezone the +/- 99.0 acres from Agriculture District "A" to Recreation Facility District "RF" with the intent to operate a campground on the property. In 2011, the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board upheld approval of the campground development, however due to unforeseen circumstances, development did not proceed within the permit's allotted timeframe. Consequently, the development permit previously issued is no longer valid. The applicants do not wish to reapply for a development permit as they no longer intend to develop a campground on this property.

K. Gilham outlined property boundaries, surrounding land uses, access roads and, applicable section of the Municipal Development Plan and Land Use Bylaw 714/01.

K. Gilham stated at the regular Council meeting held on April 10, 2018, Council reviewed and gave first reading to Bylaw 1046/18. As required by legislation, notice of today's Public Hearing was advertised in the local newspapers and comments were invited from adjacent landowners and referral agencies.

K. Gilham asked that Council consider whether to grant second and third readings to Bylaw 1046/18 upon consideration of the representations made at this Public Hearing.

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The Chair invited questions from Council regarding the proposed bylaw.
