Public Works Report

Gravel Roads

Graders have had a difficult time, over the past three to four weeks, in providing ongoing maintenance due to the abundance of moisture on road tops over the past several weeks. Hence, once some of the moisture dissipates, the graders will be out in full force to regain the level of service that is expected.

Patch gravelling is currently underway, and crews are coming out of the Frisco aggregate pit.

Surfaced Roads

Chip sealing on the Red Deer River Access Road was partially completed on September 26th, 2018. Due to inclement weather, the remaining sweeping is expected to be completed by October 5th.

Additional line painting quantities, to be completed on the Red Deer River Access Road, were pushed back due to inclement weather. We expect to schedule them in once the chip seal coat has been swept off and the forecast shows a day or two of good weather.

Route & Seal crack fill on the Prairie Creek Road was pushed back due to weather and was started on October 4th and will be completed by October 5th. Blow & Seal crack fill on the Beaver Flat Road, will be completed by the end of October.

Crews will continue with hand patching and asphalt repairs as weather permits and will help with yard and facilities maintenance as needed.

Due to the early snowfall, we have decided to down rig most of the fleet to prepare for plow season. Several loads of salt have been delivered to both the North and South Salt/Sand facilities and the sand haul to the North Facility began on October 4th. Our salt/sand pickling operation will begin shortly. We have already had to begin a modified on-call rotation with our drivers and have deployed plow trucks several times.

Maintenance

Gravel crushing, within Smith Pit, located at NE 31-37-08-W5M, began on September 17th, 2018. Once completed in the Smith Pit, crushing will commence within the Martin Pit, located at NE 13-39-08-W5M.

Condor Lift Station, Phase 2 Upgrades, started the week of August 13th, 2018. Upgrades are scheduled to be completed by October 30th, 2018.

Construction on BF 13970, located on Township Road 37-3, over the North Raven River (NE 18-37-05-W5M) was completed on September 27th, 2018.

Construction on BF 81567, located on Twp. Rd. 42-0 over the East Lobstick Creek (NE-34-41-6-W5) began on October 3rd, 2018. Construction is scheduled to be completed by October 25th, 2018, weather dependant.

Construction on BF 09970, located on Range Road 6-1 (Bingley Road), over the Lobstick Creek (NW 36-40-06-W5M) to begin on October 5th, 2018. Construction is scheduled to be completed by October 31st, 2018, weather dependant.

Gravel Road Rehabilitation

The Shoulder Pull Crew on Twp. Rd. 37-2, east of Hwy. 761, has 300 m of the 3500 m project remaining and plan to complete on October 9th, weather permitting.

The Re-Hab Crew moving to Twp. Rd. 39-0, east of the Everdell Road (Clearwater Estates) October 10th, weather permitting.

Crew on Rge. Rd. 5-4 has completed some culvert installs along with some surface gravelling in between weather events. Crew will start once weather conditions allow.

Base/Pave Projects

Taimi Road – Pidherney's has been working on the road north of the large fill and has brought the road close to grade from large fill to Hwy. 12. Large fill is close to revised grade and trimming slopes is underway. Pidherney's will work on project building and cleaning up what has been previously opened and stripped as weather conditions permit.

Nordegg Manufactured Home Park

PME plans to continue working on lot grading to prepare for shallow utility installation after the Thanksgiving long weekend. Fortis is scheduled to start installation of poles along Quarry Rd. in the spring of 2019, unless weather conditions improve.

West Country Road Project

Northfork Road Phase 2

Netook Construction has been maintaining traffic though construction area with plans to resume work after the Thanksgiving long weekend.

Facilities

New Public Works Building

Staff has started on the renovations with the general contractor to start mid October. The contractor intends on starting on the shop renovations to have it operational by mid December. The office renovation will commence after the shop is completed, pending resources available.
