Public Works Report

Gravel Roads

The Winter Gravel Program began on January 7th and is scheduled to gravel 220 miles of gravel road and will last approximately 5 weeks, weather dependent. Crews will haul out of 4 gravel pits: Cooper, Smith, Irwin, and Big Face.

Graders continuously care for all roads for the winter season by having all gravel roads, as per County policy, opened in 96 hours after any significant snowfall event. In addition, graders coordinate with Winter Gravel Program haulers to ensure that appropriate roads are graveled.

Surfaced Roads

Snow-plow operations continue, on a weekly basis, as needed, in order to mitigate any snowfall event.

The installation of snow fencing has been completed.

<u>Maintenance</u>

WSP has completed the aggregate volumetric surveys on several Clearwater County gravel pits, and the report was submitted to Clearwater County on December 19th, 2018.

Lacombe County's winter gravel haul, out of Smith Pit, is to commence on January 28th. 35,000 tonnes of ¾" gravel is to be hauled out, by Lacombe County, on a schedule of Monday to Saturday, 7am to 7pm. Anticipate haul to be completed by February 25th, as per contract.

Gravel Road Rehabilitation

Staff has begun acquiring borrow agreements and third-party consents for 2019 gravel road rehabilitation projects.

Staff are being utilized for the Winter Gravel Program.

Work has gone into winter shutdown.

Work has gone into winter shutdown.

Facilities

New Public Works Facility

The contractor and staff are continuing to work on the shop and office renovations for the New Public Works Facility. Staff are continuing to transfer parts and equipment over to the new facility. Staff will be transitioning into the office area in the coming weeks.
