Public Works Report

Gravel Roads

Summer Grader operations have begun. Roads are being assessed on a continuous basis. Due to the abundant amount of rainfall, black dirt elevated roadways are a continued concern and are being dealt with daily. As a result, the diligent application of gravel crush, to assist with the upkeep of these and all roads within Clearwater County, is ongoing. In addition, dust and washboard conditions are of continued concern and are presently being addressed as quickly as possible.

Surfaced Roads

Crews began the cold pour crack seal program the week of June 10th. They have already completed the Airport Access Road (Twp. Rd. 40-0) and the Taimi Road (Rge. Rd. 6-5).

The Dust Control application program, both on residential and high maintenance areas, has begun. However, the program is currently on hold due to inclement weather. Warranty maintenance and repair work, of dust control programs still in effect, is ongoing.

Maintenance

The inspection and installation of culverts is on-going. Due to abundant rainfall, examination of washouts is occurring on a frequent basis.

Crushing, of the previously excavated material in the Smith Pit into 3/4" gravel, commenced on June 20th.

Seasonal deficiency work will be commencing on BF 81567 (NE-34-41-6-W5, Twp. Rd. 42-0 east of the Oras Rd.) which was replaced in 2018. The road will be closed, starting the week of July 1st, to re-excavate the road material to ensure proper freeze/thaw resistance in the future.

Bridge repairs were completed, to mitigate bridge deck deterioration, on BF 09155 on Rge. Rd. 5-4 south of Hwy. 11 (NE-20-38-5-W5) and BF 02394 on the Caroline South Rd. (NE-11-36-6-W5).

Final deficiency repair work, to bridge structure BF 09970 (bridge on Bingley Road north of Highway 12), has been completed. Final inspection completed the week of June 17th.

Project tender, for the upgrading of the Condor Wastewater Lagoon, has closed. All bids are currently being reviewed.

Project tender, for the replacement of BF 79392, on Twp. Rd. 37-2 west of Stauffer (NW-9-37-5-W5), closed with Formula Alberta Ltd. being the successful bidder.

Project tender, for the replacement of BF 09293, on the south end of the Wall Street Road (NE-33-36-4-W5), has been put out with a closing date of June 27th.

County signs and delineators continue to be installed, replaced, and repaired as needed.

Beaver dam issues are being dealt with on an as needed basis.

Gravel Road Rehabilitation

Spring Road Assessments continue as roads continue to settle. Assessments are at about 95% completed. Remaining roads are mostly in the green zone.

Weather has slowed progress of road rehabilitation as rain has stopped work for most of the past two weeks. Road Re-Hab Crew working on Rge. Rd. 5-2 has approximately 2600 m of the 3200 m project roughed in. Water pumping is ongoing.

Road Re-Hab crew on Rge. Rd. 6-4 south of Twp. Rd. 39-2 for approximately 2000 m. Crew has approximately 1000m of the project roughed in with water pumping underway.

Shoulder Pull crew has finished Twp. Rd. 37-2A from Rge. Rd. 4-5 to RR 4-3 (3.2 km). Crew will begin work on Twp. Rd. 40-2 from Rge. Rd. 5-1 to Rge. Rd. 5-5 (6.4 km) when weather permits.

Northfork Road

Netook Construction had scheduled a final inspection of the Phase 2 project on June 21st but was postponed due to rain. Inspection will take place when ground conditions allow.

Beaver Flat Road

The Beaver Flat Road project includes the Grading and Other Work from Hwy. 12 to approximately 4.5 km north. Howitt Construction Ltd has a tentative start date of early July.

Township Road 41-2 (Frisco Pit Road)

Public Works is underway in planning to add this road in its 2019 construction schedule.

Nordegg

Manufactured Home Park

PME had begun to finish landscaping last week until rain shut them down.

Primary had their pre-construction meeting in Nordegg on June 20th and plan to start with shallow utilities installation as soon as weather permits. Plan to complete project in 20 working days.

Quarry Road

MPE has prepared road grade line design for 2019 Quarry Road Grading Project to prepare for future paving. Construction tentatively scheduled for early September.

Facilities

Condor Public Services Building

Pidherney's is scheduled to tie in the sanitary service and Eagle Builders are scheduled to commence construction as soon as site conditions will allow.

Main Administration Building

Renovations are ongoing for the New Server Room, I.T. Lab and Office Space. Next steps include electrical fixtures, paint and furniture.
